

ACT, SAT, PSAT/NMSQT, and AP Testing Accommodations

If a student currently has an IEP or 504 Plan with testing accommodations, there is an additional separate application process for requesting accommodations for **both** the College Board exams and the ACT. College Board and ACT will review the request, then approve/deny accommodations for their respective test(s). A current IEP or 504 Plan does not guarantee approval of accommodations for these exams. The final decision is up to College Board and ACT.
