Graduation Requirements

24 credits must be earned in all the following:

- English 1, 2, 3, and 4
- Algebra, Geometry, and two additional math courses
- Biology and two additional sciences
- World History, US History, Government, and Economics
- 1 Fine and performing art, speech and debate, career and technical education, or practical arts
- HOPE
- Financial Literacy (.50 credit)
- 7.5 elective credits - If you're planning to attend college, you will need two credits in the SAME world language

2.0 unweighted, cumulative GPA

Must pass two assessments – Algebra 1 EOC and 10th grade FAST ELA (PM3)

World Language

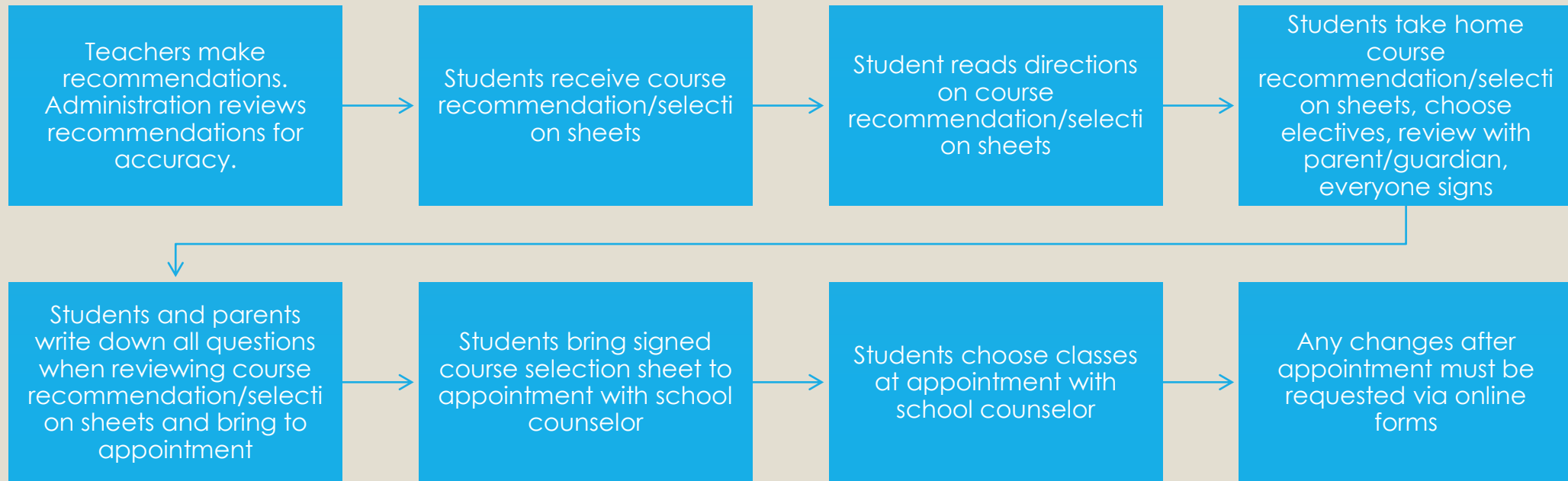
- Not required for high school graduation

- In order to take a World Language freshman year, students should have a FAST ELA score of 3 or higher
- Will count as elective credit

Grades – A grade of “C” or better in the previous honors course. Students earning an “A” in a previous standard class, may be recommended for Honors, AICE, or AP

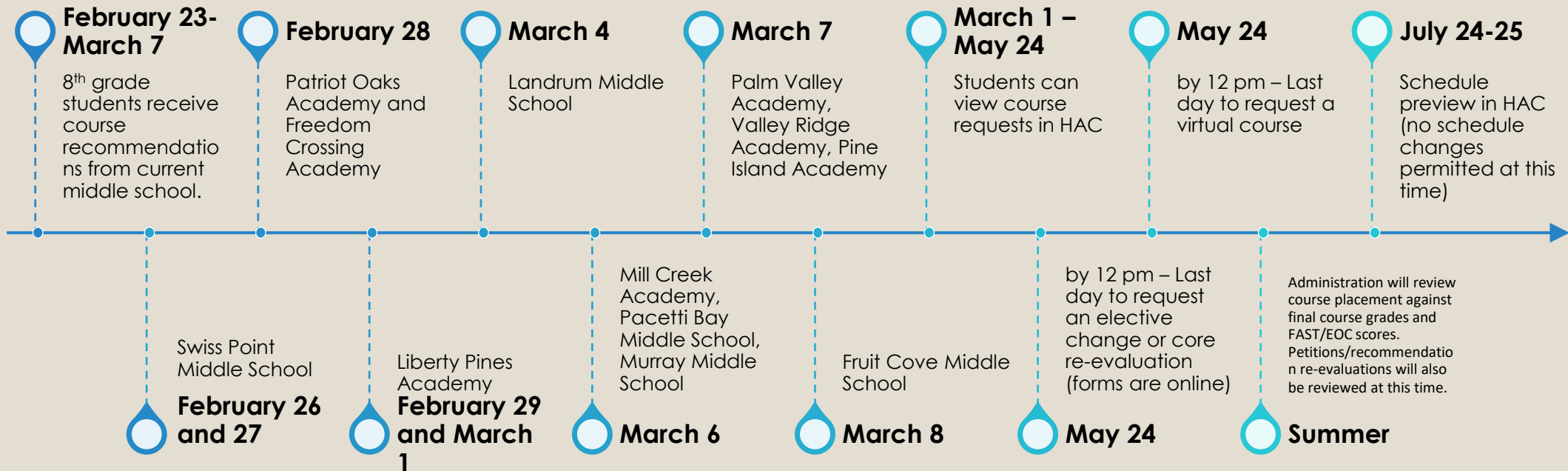
FAST/EOC – Level 4 or 5 in appropriate area and no less than a level 3 in any area

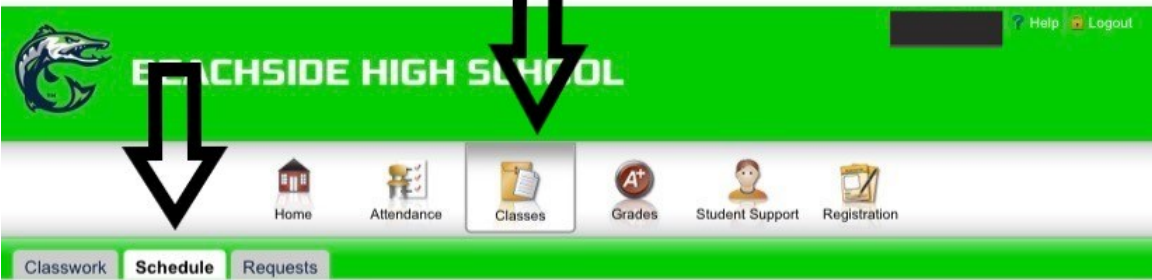

How to view Course Recommendations in HAC – Viewable from March 1-May 24

- Log into STUDENT HAC account
- Click Classes icon
- Click Schedule tab

Request Changes vs. Schedule Changes

- Students can request the following when sitting with a counselor during their appointment in February:
 - Electives
 - Core Re-Evaluation (student will need to fill out a form to go into a higher-level course)
 - Virtual lab (deadline to request the course on FLVS is May 24)
- There are **no schedule changes**, so make sure recommendations and requests are correct by May 24. Students can view their requests and recommendations in HAC from March 1 – May 24.



AICE, AP, or Honors Course Level Changes – SJCSD Policy

- AICE, AP, and Honors course levels can only be changed at the **semester** IF ...
 - Student has a D or F and
 - Student has consistently attended help sessions and
 - Parent and student have had a teacher conference and
 - There is a seat available in the desired course

Intensive Reading

- Schools are required by the District Decision Tree to possibly place students in intensive reading if they score a level 1 or 2 on the FAST ELA Reading PM 3
 - Administration will review FAST scores and other data during the summer and students will be placed in an intensive reading course as needed.

Grade Point Average

- EVERYTHING COUNTS IN HIGH SCHOOL
- GPA's update after every semester (8 times total in high school):
 - In January, after semester 1 grades post
 - In the summer, after semester 2 grades post
- Only cumulative unweighted GPA counts towards graduation and qualifications for Dual Enrollment
- AICE, AP, Dual Enrollment, and honors counts towards your weighted GPA
- Bright Futures GPA will be different from Beachside GPA (they recalculate based on only certain classes)

Self Advocacy

If a student is absent, it is the student's responsibility to ask the teacher for make up work and turn it in

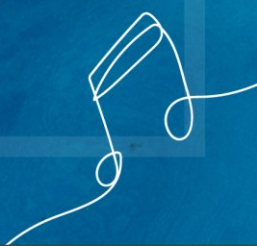
