How To Apply

All applications for scholarships must be accompanied by certain documentation, a list of which is included in the application. To facilitate the work of the screening committee, the following applications for scholarships must be submitted no later than May 30,2025.

To qualify the student must meet the following:

Eligibility: All students are invited to participate – public, private, parochial, charter, military and homeschoolers whose primary residence is in Northeast Florida and who will be graduating from high school at the end of the current school year 2025.

Application:

- The student must complete all areas of the application.
- The guidance counselor must complete their portion of the application. Be sure to have your guidance counselor complete and sign their portion to ensure that your application will be completed and emailed or mailed prior to the May 30th deadline.
- **One** letter of recommendation (from a principal, guidance counselor, teacher, employer, minister, family friend, or community leader) is required and **must accompany the application**.

Application Deadline: Scholarship applications must be completed and received by May 30, 2025.

Notification: Scholarship winners will be notified by mail or email by August 1, 2025.

Qualifications: The selections are based on community involvement, extracurricular, academic achievements. and recommendations are the primary considerations.

- Essay requirements: Essay will be uploaded as a PDF if emailed
- Double Spaced, 1 inch margins
- Font, Size: Times New Roman, 12 pt.

Minimum & maximum word-count

1,200 - 1,500 words

References are not included in word count.

- No more than one student at a given public school can receive a scholarship, and not every school will have a scholarship recipient.
- No more than two students representing the private/home school category can receive a scholarship.
- ** Quoted material should be used sparingly and must include a citation of author, publication and date
- **The use of Artificial Intelligence sources is prohibited. Essays written with the help of AI bots will be disqualified.

Name and address of community college, college, or university you will be attending in the Fall 2025. Please give address to mail funds and NOT the main address.

Disbursement: A check in the amount of \$1,000.00 will be mailed directly to the scholarship recipient college or university. The scholarship recipient is to provide The Nolan Carroll Foundation with a copy of their college registration documentation and college address to submit the scholarship payment.

Deadline: College Registration documentation must be received no later than **November 7, 2025** to receive the scholarship award. Scholarships are <u>nonrenewable</u>. Any scholarship recipient who **has not** submitted their documentation by the November 14th deadline will forfeit their scholarship.
