### APPLICANT MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA

- Must be a child, grandchild or legal dependent of a Farm Bureau member.
- Must be a resident of Putnam or St. Johns counties.
- Must be a high school senior with a 2025 graduation date.

All decisions given to scholarships are approved by The Board of Directors of Putnam-St Johns County Farm Bureau and are final. Three scholarships will be awarded at \$2000 each. For all scholarships, priority will be given to students actively involved in agriculture through 4-H, FFA, or other personal endeavors in addition to the scholarship requirements.
