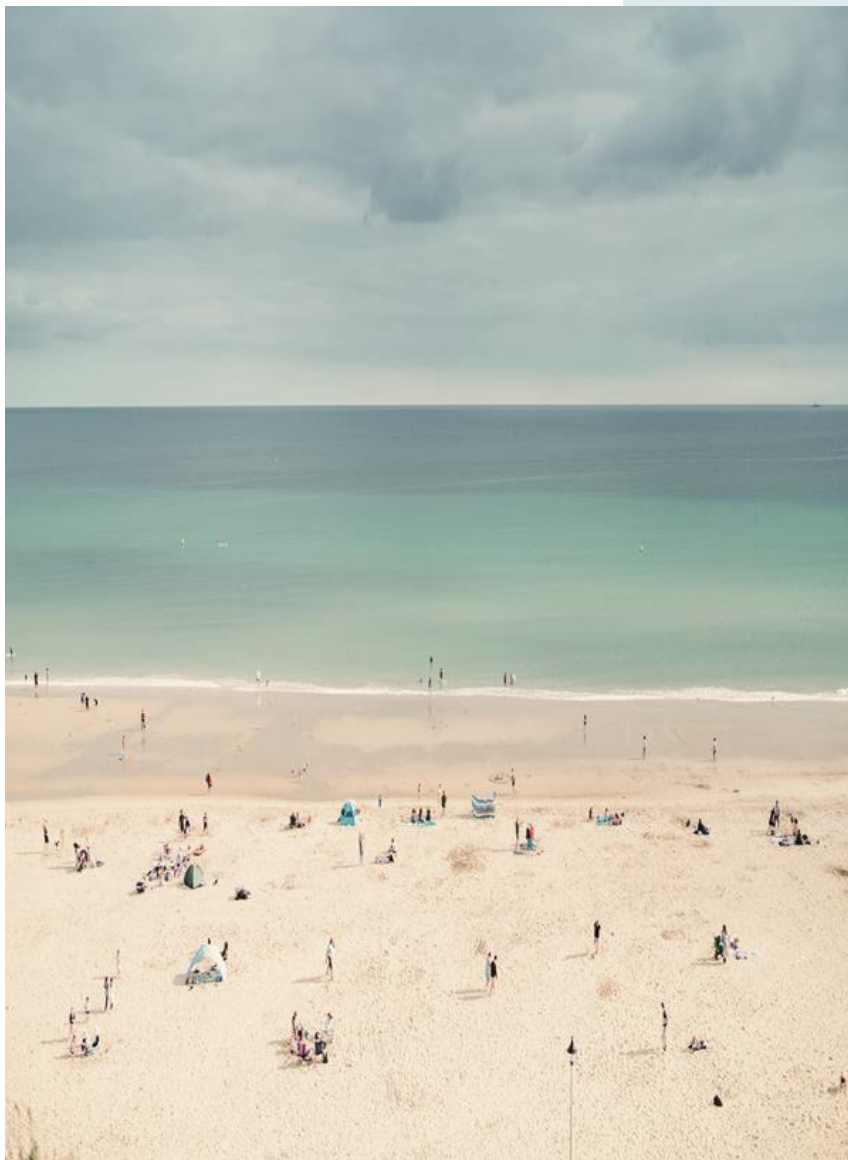

 - Juniors will receive their Bright Futures reports and learn what to expect during the college application process.

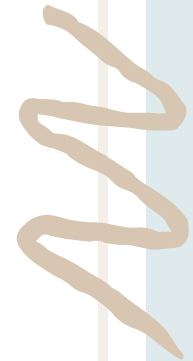
Class of 2029– Lessons & Help

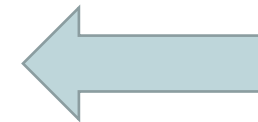
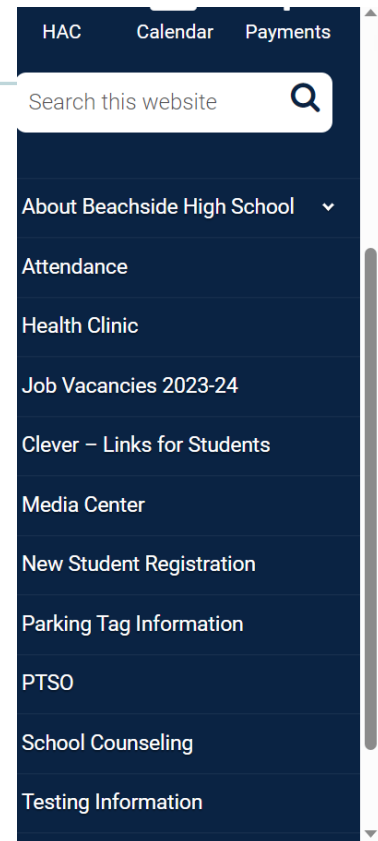

FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Assessments

- Must pass two assessments to graduate with diploma
 - Algebra 1 EOC (level 3 or above) or
 - ACT Math – 16 or
 - SAT Math – 420 or
 - PSAT/NMSQT Math – 430 or
 - Geometry EOC – Level 3 or
 - CLT Quantitative Reasoning section - 14
 - Grade 10 ELA FAST or
 - ACT Reading and English average – 18 or
 - SAT Evidence-Based Reading and Writing – 490 or
 - PSAT/NMSQT Reading and Writing – 470 or
 - CLT Verbal Reasoning and Grammar/Writing sections sum - 39

GPA

- GPA - 2.0 cumulative unweighted or higher
 - 2.0 is a "C" average
 - Check HAC regularly to keep track of grades

Credits

- 24 credits must be earned in all the following:
 - English 1, 2, 3, and 4
 - Algebra, Geometry, and two additional math courses
 - Biology and two additional sciences
 - World History, US History, Government, Personal Financial Literacy, and Economics
 - Fine and Performing Arts, Speech and Debate, Career and Technical Education, or Practical Arts
 - HOPE
 - 7.5 elective credits
 - If you're planning to attend college, you will need two credits in the SAME world language

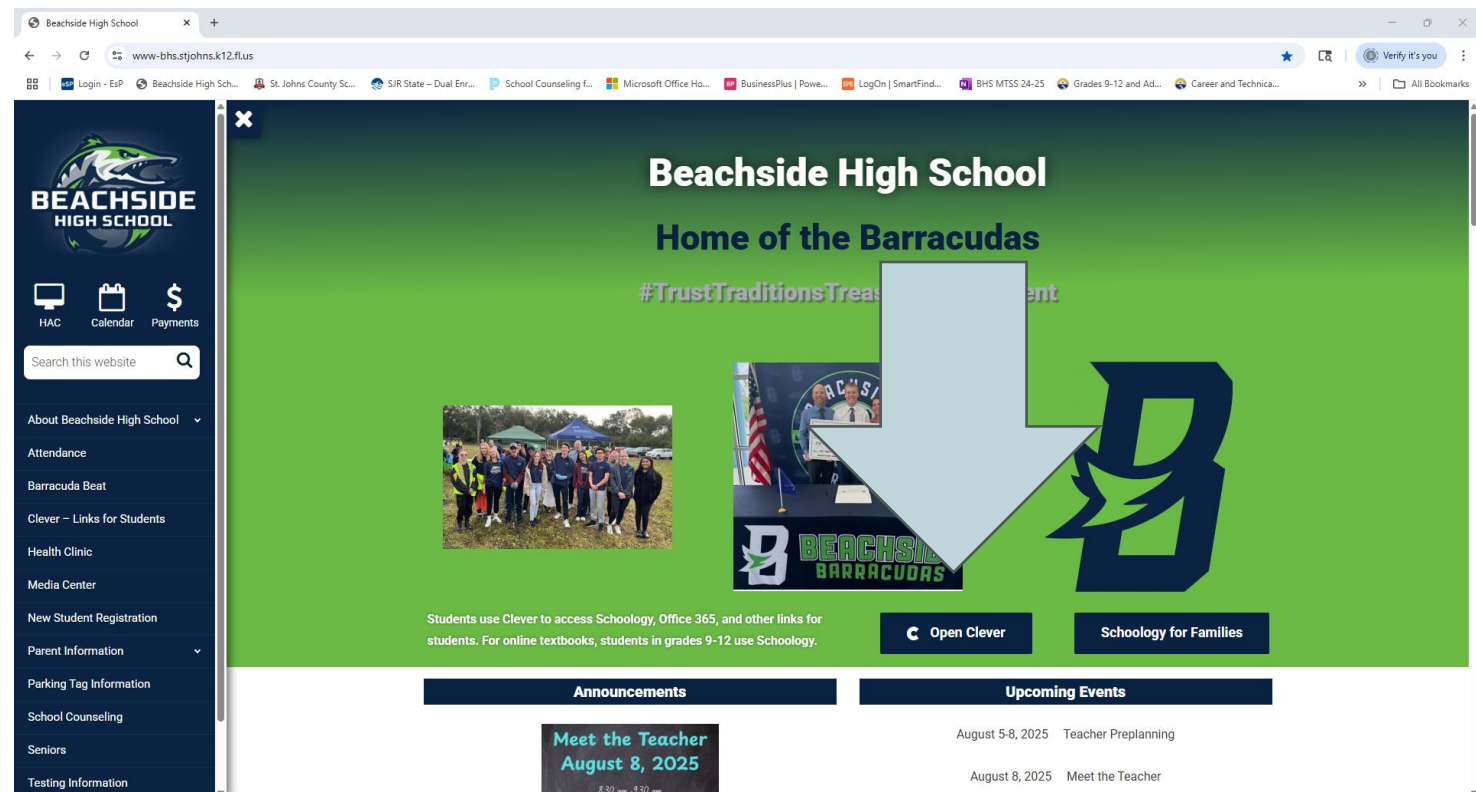

Clever & Active Directory Information

Home Access Center (HAC) – Login Info

Parent Log In:

Parents got an email from the computer operator (either Ms. Daley or Ms. Houser) with their HAC username (which is the email address that was provided by you when you registered your student) and a temporary password

When a parent logs in for the first time, you will be asked to change your password

Student Log In:

Students will get their active directory information today which includes their HAC login.

Do not misplace this information.

Take a photo of your username and password.

How to check out a student and report an absence ...

1. When students need to be checked out before the end of the school day, an early check out form should be submitted no later than 10 am the day of check-out.
2. When a student is absent, please send a note with the student when they return to class. Please note the excuses absence list in the SJCSD Student Progression Plan.
3. If a student is absent for more than 15 days, a doctor's note will be required to excuse further absences.

How to get a digital ID and locker ...

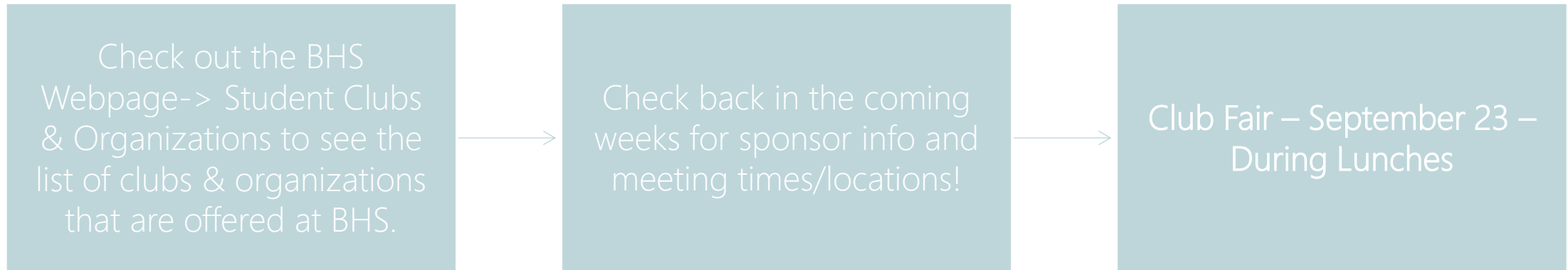
1. All students will use their student ID to check books out from the media center and to purchase lunches. They will also use them at the SWIPE machines as various times during the school year.

Steps to play a sport for BHS

1. Scan QR code for all forms
2. Gather the following items:
 - a. An updated physical on the appropriate FHSAA EL2 form (found on the athletics website)
 - b. Proof of taking 3 on-line courses in the athlete's name (not parents name)
 - 1) FHSAA Heat Illness Certificate
 - 2) FHSAA Sudden Cardiac Arrest Certificate
 - 3) FHSAA Concussion Video Certificate
3. Register with the FHSAA by going to www.athleticclearance.com
4. Once you reach the confirmation message the data will be electronically filed with the Beachside Athletic Department for review.
5. When your student is cleared, you will receive an email from the BHS athletic department.

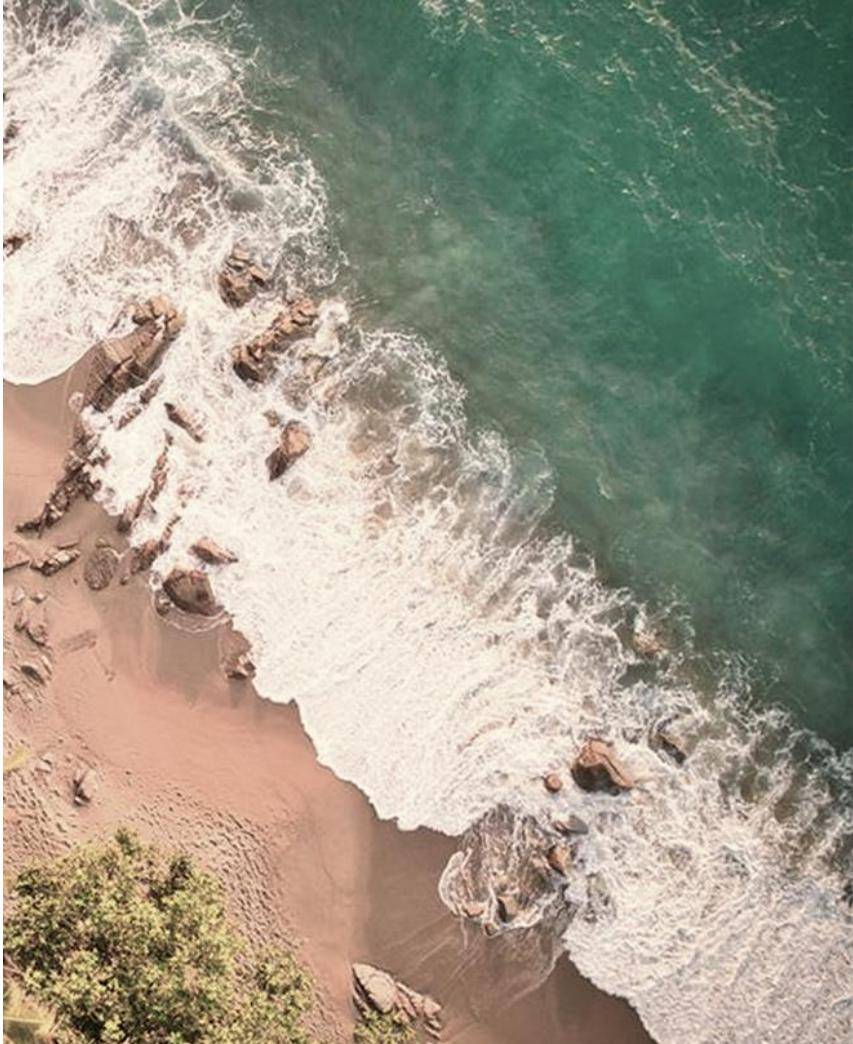
