Acknowledgement of Participation Requirements Form

We have read and understand the bylaws for the BHS Chapter of the National Honor Society. The following are the student's obligations as a member:

- Attendance at meetings is mandatory. Meetings are held once a month for approximately 30 minutes. The day and time of the meeting is decided by the NHS Executive Committee prior to the start of each school year (currently the first Thursday of each month at 8:45am in the auditorium at BHS). I understand that if I miss more than two monthly meetings I will be dismissed from the club.
- I understand that I am expected to earn at least 20 hours of community service hours each academic year, with an additional 5 points of NHS Participation hours (only recorded through the club and do NOT count toward bright futures), which include, donations, teacher appreciation week, and school related activities. Work hours do NOT count as community service hours.
- I understand that membership is based upon selection by an anonymous Faculty Council and that the proceedings of this council and all materials presented to it will be held in confidence by the school administration.
- Maintaining a high level of conduct is expected as a member of NHS. Failure to do so (level 3 offense or higher) will result in dismissal from the club.
- Member dues are collected upon acceptance into NHS. (\$35 for new members, which include a T-shirt)
- I understand that failure to attend meetings, maintain my academic or disciplinary standing, or failure to participate in activities will be grounds for dismissal.
