- Go Over Bylaws and approval:
  - Tracy Chamberlain motions to approve, Heather Vitell 2<sup>nd</sup>, Approved unanimously.
- SAC Meeting Dates and time and approval:
  - Heather Vitell motioned to approved dates, Tracy chamberlain 2nds, Approved unanimously.

- What is SAC
  - School Improvement Plan:
    - Heather Vitell: Is SAC supposed to be in an active role in the Club Fair on Friday Sept 15? The students run the Club Fair.

Students have full access to the whole campus. 1950 enrolled students, and an additional 40 staff members this year. 3 Deans, 3 Assistant Principals, and 4 School Counselors. Full-time AICE Coordinator for more than 500 students enrolled in AICE classes. Questions: Tracy Chamberlain: How is the adjusted start time? Working with the transportation department, the logistics of the buses on SR 210 would be nearly impossible for the buses to arrive on time. Choosing to move the start time back has let more than 200 students arrive on time for 1<sup>st</sup> period.
- JP Swope introduction as new Assistant Principal. Tracy Chamberlain: Is there a possibility of having a therapy dog for the ESE program since we have the Pupacuda Program? That is something to look into providing for ESE students.
- Student perspective update
  - Ashwini is involved in the Paws for a Cause club and volunteers with the Jax Humane Society.
- Funds Requests: No funds requests currently.
- Other concerns: Tracy Chamberlain: Some students with modified schedules without an English class miss important updates in English class. Michelle Sterling responds: The counselors have been reaching out directly to students in dual enrollment and modified schedules.
