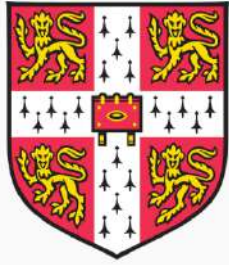

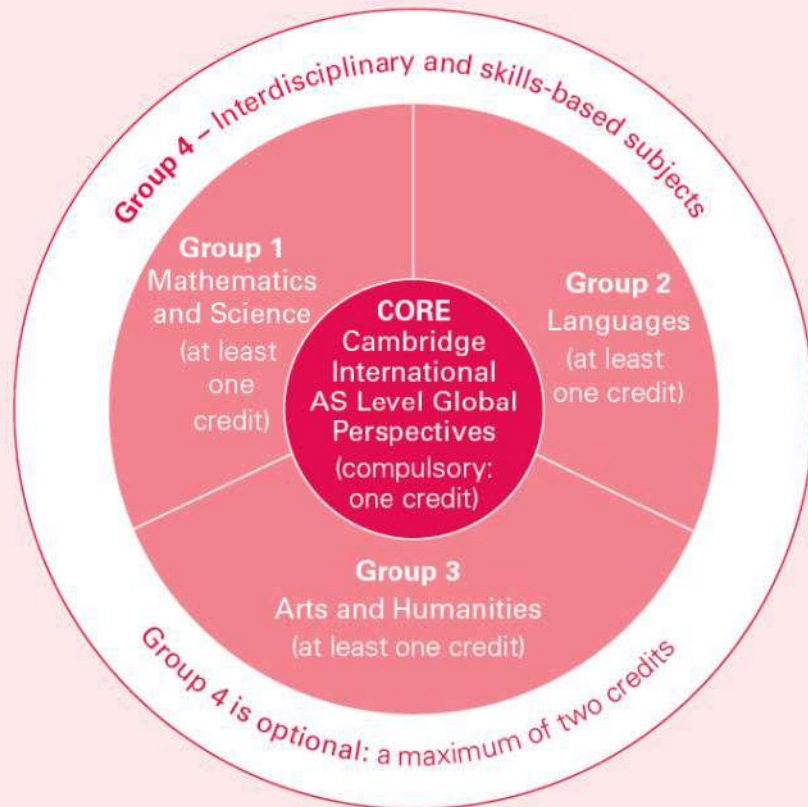
What is AICE?

Why Choose AICE?

- Students can earn college credit for passing scores in every AICE Level exam
- With passing scores, a student may enroll in a university with up to 45 hours of college credit.

St. Johns Technical High School serves the district as a School of Choice providing an individualized and supportive learning environment for students grades 8 – 12. Many students who attend St. Johns Tech have an IEP or a 504 plan, but it is not a requirement. Class sizes are smaller than the average high school which can benefit students with academic or social needs. Transportation is provided to all students in St. Johns County.

Early Career



The FCTC Early Career Program creates an opportunity for eligible students to enroll in college level courses and earn industry certification and licensure in high demand career fields, all while still enrolled in high school.

This offering is an application-based program, and students accepted will attend Saint Augustine High School. Students will be placed on an accelerated high school course progression for an 18-credit CTE diploma while dual enrolling at FCTC beginning in the sophomore year. Students will complete the FCTC program during high school and will not need to enroll after graduation for any remaining hours.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 2.0 GPA
- No level 4 behavior infractions
- Level 2 or higher in ELA and Math
- *Students must have the social and emotional maturity to handle college level coursework and a college classroom*

 - Opens January 4, 2024
 - Closes January 31, 2024 @ 5:00 pm
- If applying for IB or AICE, request a completed Teacher Recommendation form from your four core content area teachers.
- If applying for SJCCA, apply and audition by January 24, 2024.

Students must apply through their HAC login. Application will NOT be available through parent login.

Current St. Johns County residents must apply during application window.

Non-SJCSD students must pre-register for following school year and apply during application window.

Late Application may not be used for a secondary application

- Multiple 1st Choice Options
- Applications for a duplicate program at zoned school
- Multiple applications for one student
- More than three selections
- Duplicate Academy selections
- Student is already enrolled in an Academy
