- Treasurer's Report: \$2566.21 currently
- School recognition funds approval (next school year): Majority Faculty voted for 100% to be dispersed to faculty and staff. Move to approve: Bradley Sohn 2nd: Ryan Sirak
 - Question: Vitell: How did we get the money last year? Some funds are set aside by the state specifically to use for SAC, the School Recognition funds would've been extra on top of that.
- SAC CHAIR voting: Bradley volunteers to continue, Unanimous motion to approve and unanimous approval.
- Funds Requests:
 - ESE garden, Michael Owens move to approve Christy Sohn, 2nd Tracy Chaplain approved.
 - Math Conference, Selena Robinson Tracy Chamberlain: Move to approve with an increase of \$166 to \$332 per diem for 4 teachers to attend if 4 teachers attend if it all gets used. 2nd Ryan Sirak, approved.
- Principal's Report: Numbers for next year projected to 2100 students. 5-7 additional staff will be needed. 10-12 Portable classrooms will be installed next year located behind building 4 and some teachers have already requested to be moved out to a portable. Recognitions: Star Banquet to recognize our top 3 percent. DECA state competition recently, ten of our students are going to nationals. Performing Arts will be performing Legally Blonde. The SAC survey has rolled out, we need people to take the survey and hit the "done" button.
- Ryan Sirak:
 - Graduation updates: Caps and gowns will be delivered shortly. April 26 is Gradbash, May 10 is the last school day for seniors, May 11 is prom. May 14 is senior debt day. May 16 is graduation rehearsal 1pm-3pm at UNF arena. End of April/May is when tickets will be released. Graduation May 20; school will be released at 12:30 that day to allow for everyone to arrive by 4pm. Information Packets for students who miss rehearsal. Senior event with food and fun during May 3-10.

- Testing starts next week with ACT for Juniors only on March 26, then there is some form of testing April 1- June. Certain days in April and May will be designated to be block-scheduled to rotate classes missed due to modified schedules for testing. This will not change the time of school or dismissal.
- Counselor Report: Mollie Altick: Guidance Counselors began in November planning for registration. Currently middle school visits are complete. In June and July, the transfer students will have appointments. Counselors review courses with students with the whole picture in mind, including after high school. May 24th is the lock-down day for registration. No course changes will be made after May 24th. Requests for changes are currently open and available in links on the Guidance website. Counselors will begin visiting classes for the Juniors to prepare for college and the ACT test.
