- Principal's Report- Greg Bergamasco: About 2400 students enrolled, additional staff added on, including a new AP. A \$500,000 grant for the Logistics Academy. About 47% of students at BHS are enrolled in an academy. 27% of students are enrolled in the AICE program; 59% of students are enrolled in at least one AICE course. Family night beginning November 5th- no homework, no events, no practice. Thursday of homecoming week- Golf Cart Parade.
- Questions: Q: What was the Junior Class Ring presentation today? Mrs. Sohn Responded- Class Rings for Juniors are available for purchase online through Jostens. Q: What will be happening with the expansion of the school? Mr. Bergamasco responded- there are some plans to expand the parking lot. Q: Is there a certification coming for the BioMed academy? Mr. Bergamasco responded, we are attempting to connect some certifications to the academy. Q: Are there any solutions to the traffic situation? No updates available yet, PTSO responded-potentially January. Q: Can we increase computer resources, there isn't enough in the computer cart in the classroom? Mr. Bergamasco responded, we are looking to add more carts, up to 36 potentially.
