ACCEPTANCE LETTERS

- Seniors should keep turning in acceptance letters (vocational college, and military plans) and scholarship award letters as they roll in! All of them, even if they aren't planning on attending that school
 - Ways you can turn all of your acceptance letters and scholarship offers from your online portal to Suzanne.Patterson@stjohns.k12.fl.us. Make a copy of the acceptance letters and scholarship offers and drop them by my office in building 1.
 - As of 2/4/2026 – 608 total acceptance and military enlistments turned in and \$3,913,000 worth of scholarship awards.

FREE APPLICATION DAYS

- If you are interested in either SJRSC or FSCJ, both schools will be on the Beachside campus for free application days!
 - FSCJ – Thursday, March 26, 11:15-2:30, Media Center
 - SJRSC – Friday, March 27, 11:15-2:30, Media Center
 - Seniors should have their social security number memorized for application.
 - No need to sign up ahead of time, just stop by the media center with a pass from your teacher or during your modified period.
 - Both schools are waiving application fees and will have reps on site to answer questions.

DEADLINES FOR FINAL EVALUATION FOR BRIGHT FUTURE SCHOLARSHIP

- May 21st – Complete and turn in work service hours to Guidance Office
 - SJCSD will automatically send all final transcripts to FLDOE for final evaluation
 - **Evaluation based on test scores
 - To ensure the Office of Student Financial Assistance obtains official test scores:
 - Ensure demographics on the test registration and high school transcript match (name, address, social security number, date of birth); and
 - Request the official single sitting test scores be sent to one of Florida's public colleges or state universities when registering for the ACT, CLT or SAT.

TRANSCRIPTS

- All transcripts should be ordered via Parchment
 - <https://www.parchment.com/u/registration/61659587/institution>
 - It is recommended that students (not their parents) use their personal email address for Parchment; do not use your SJCS D issued email address.
 - Seniors should order their final transcript to be sent to post-secondary institutions starting May 1. Seniors should use the HOLD FOR GRADES option when requesting a final transcript.
 - Seniors have taken dual enrollment courses must order both their high school transcript and their college transcript. Click [HERE](#) to order transcripts from SJRSC.
