Parking Policies & Expectations

The following expectations exist to ensure the safest and most efficient use of our parking facilities. All juniors will be allowed to buy a parking pass beginning on the date specified below, provided availability.

- A 2026-2027 School Year Parking Pass costs \$150. *Parking passes are non-refundable and non-transferable.*
 - Payments will be made via Schoolpay. No other forms of payment will be accepted.
 - If parking pass is lost, an additional charge of \$25 will be needed to replace the pass.
 - If a parking violation is identified, a \$20.00 fine will be assessed.
 - Parking spots will be assigned by the school
 - Students must be licensed driver by the end of 1st quarter (October 9th)
- Purchase Windows for Parking Pass:
 - **Juniors (Rising Seniors):** The first window will open on April 13 and all rising seniors will be allowed to purchase through any subsequent windows of availability.
 - **Sophomores (Rising Juniors):** At this time, preference for parking spots will be given to seniors. Based upon availability we will open parking permit sales to rising juniors only on May 4. At that time, we will send out the necessary information ahead-of-time via school messenger and post it on the school website.
 - *Seniors who would like to custom paint their parking spots, the charge will be an additional \$80.00 and you will need to provide your painting supplies. All artwork must be approved by the Dean's office prior to painting date. Students and parents must sign the painting agreement before painting will be permitted. Painting must be done by student and or family members, no third party/professional painters permitted.*
- Required paperwork will be required at parking pass pick up August 1st 8:30-11:30 a.m. The parking pass will be handed out at that time. Students cannot park on campus without their pass.
 - Required paperwork:
 - Copy of valid driver's license, registration, and insurance copied onto one piece of paper.
 - Signed copy of BHS Parking Expectations

Parking Expectations

- Your parking tag must be visible on your rearview mirror while parked. (\$20.00 non-compliance fine)
- Student's must park in their assigned parking zone.
- Students with a silver pass MUST park in the assigned spot that matches their parking pass number.
- If you need to take a different car to school other than the one on file, you must report to the Dean's office upon arrival to school with a copy of the registration.
- Parking passes are non-transferable & cannot be shared with others. (\$20.00 fine non-compliance and possible loss of driving privileges).
- You must be in good standing with attendance and discipline to be able to continue to drive on campus. (Following student code of conduct and truancy rules to remain in good standing). Parking passes may be revoked and/or denied based upon attendance guidelines and disciplinary actions.
- You are expected to follow all traffic laws inside the parking lot and school zones. (Failure to do so will be classified as reckless driving). If a student gets a traffic ticket on campus, driving privileges will be revoked for 9 weeks.
- Loitering in the parking lot before or after school is not permitted. Upon arrival at school students must exit their vehicle and enter campus. At the end of the day, all students must leave school grounds unless attending a school-sponsored activity. You must be with a supervising adult after 4:20 p.m.
- The parking area is off limits to all students during the school day. You must get a pass from the dean's office if you need access to your vehicle. **Students entering the parking lot without a pass will be subject to automatic search of the vehicle and a 2-week parking suspension.**
- All vehicles are subject to search under reasonable suspicion. Possession of drugs, alcohol, tobacco products/paraphernalia, weapons or contraband not in compliance with the St. Johns County Code of Conduct will result in an out of school suspension & loss of parking privileges. Not knowing that these items were in your vehicle will not change the consequences.
- Neither BHS nor the St. Johns County School District are responsible for any damages or losses to vehicles parked on campus.

The following offenses, including parking violations, could result in suspension and revocation of parking pass:

- Excessive tardies / unexcused absences will result in loss of parking privileges for 1 week but may progress.
- Leaving campus without permission will result in a suspension of parking privileges for 2 weeks, as well as student receiving out-of-school suspension.
- Unlawful speeding, texting on your phone while operating vehicle, or reckless driving on campus will result in a 2-week suspension of parking pass.
- Level 4 disciplinary actions per the St. John County Student Code of Conduct will result in permanent revocation of parking pass.
- Repeated violation of school rules, Student Code of Conduct (i.e. skipping class, defiance/disrespect, inappropriate conduct, class disruptions) will result in a 2-week parking suspension
- Students found on campus with another student's parking pass, or a counterfeit parking pass, or selling their parking pass will automatically result in the loss of the student's parking pass and \$20.00 non-compliance fine.
- If a student receives a parking ticket it must be paid within 5 days or the parking pass will be suspended for two weeks.

***If a student loses their parking privileges, the vehicle registered to that parking pass is not allowed on campus & the tag will be confiscated. Refunds will not be given to students who lose their parking privileges (suspended or revoked) for disciplinary reasons.**
